Section 4: First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

Skin contact: Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin.

Drench the affected skin with running water for 10 minutes or longer if substance is still

on skin. Transfer to hospital if there are burns or symptoms of poisoning.

Eye contact: Immediately irrigate with eyewash solution or clean water, holding the eyelids apart, for

at least 10 minutes. Obtain immediate medical attention.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention immediately! Immediately rinse mouth

and drink plenty of water. Call an embulance. Bring along these instructions. Do not induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs, the head should be kept low so that stomach vomit doesn't enter the lungs. Give 1 cup of water to drink every 10 minutes. If unconscious,

check for breathing and apply artificial respiration if necessary. If unconscious and

breathing is OK, place in the recovery position. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

Inhalation: Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. If

unconscious and breathing is OK, place in the recovery position. If conscious, ensure the casualty sits or lies down. If breathing becomes bubbly, have the casualty sit and

provide oxygen if available. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

Contain spillages with sand, earth or any suitable absorbent material. Collect and dispose of spillage as indicated in section 13.

6.3. Methods and material for containment and cleaning up

Clean-up procedures: Clean-up should be dealt with only by qualified personnel familiar with the specific
