Designed to be a 1 tin solution for virtually every job in the great outdoors.

Benefits of using Bird Brand OUTDOORS include:

Safe to use and quick drying – non-cracking – anti-fungal – long lasting colours – simple satin finish -no primer required*.

<u>Wood-</u> Ideal for Decking, Sheds, Summerhouses, carports, building cladding, gates, bird boxes, garden furniture, planters and fencing.

Masonry- including terracotta, brick, and stone.

Plastic- guttering and cladding

Metal – benches, gates and tables.

Preparation: Please ensure the surface is clean, dry and free from decay, lichen or algae. Apply **Bird Brand Fungicidal Wash** and allow to dry.

<u>Wood</u>- Bare or untreated wood should be pre-treated with **Bird Brand Superior Clear Wood Preserver** to help prevent rot and decay. Ensure the ends are adequately protected. The lighter colours when used on very resinous timbers may require a blocking primer.

<u>Metal</u> *showing signs of rust will require a rub down and a coat of **Bird Brand Red**Oxide Primer or application of **Bird Brand Grey Spray Primer**.

<u>Masonry/Plastic:</u> - Lightly rub down the surface for a better key. Ensuring the surface is clean and dry. Dilute the first coat with water by 10% especially if very dry.

All procedures to be carried out in accordance with BS6150:2006+A1:2014. Code of practice for Painting of Buildings'. Be advised that for the tinting of a special colour or if

using multiple tins of the same shade, we recommend testing on a small area to determine suitability and acceptance before commencing.



Application- Stir and shake the tin well before use. A minimum of 2 coats is recommended. Bird Brand OUTDOORS Paint can be applied using a brush, a foam roller applied or through a HVLP sprayer. Do not apply in wet or cold conditions below 10° C. or if rain or frost is likely. Apply a generous first coat in the direction of the grain, back brush to ensure an even coverage. Allow a minimum of 2 hours between coats. This product is not recommended for indoor use.

Coverage: 8-10m₂ per litre on timber. 12-14m₂ on plastic and metal.

Clean up: Remove as much product from the brush and clean with water. Even though this product is water based, please follow the basic safety instructions on this tin. Any splashing should be cleaned up immediately (whilst still wet) and then hot water and household liquid detergent to avoid spreading. Many local authorities offer

special facilities for disposal of waste materials. Do not empty into drains or watercourses.

PRECAUTIONS

Keep out of reach of children and pets. Children and pets should be kept away until dry. Protect from frost. Use only in well ventilated areas. Do not use at temperatures below 10°C or in conditions of high humidity. To avoid risk of spillage always store and transport in a secure and upright position. Colour label indicates approximate colour only. The treatment of a test area to determine final colour is recommended. Please note Bird Brand cannot be held responsible for incidence, failure to perform or damage to or resulting from the use of third-party spraying equipment.

This product is only for use as directed. As the manufacturer cannot know all the uses its products may be put to, it is the user's responsibility to determine suitability for use. If in doubt, contact our Technical Department for advice.
