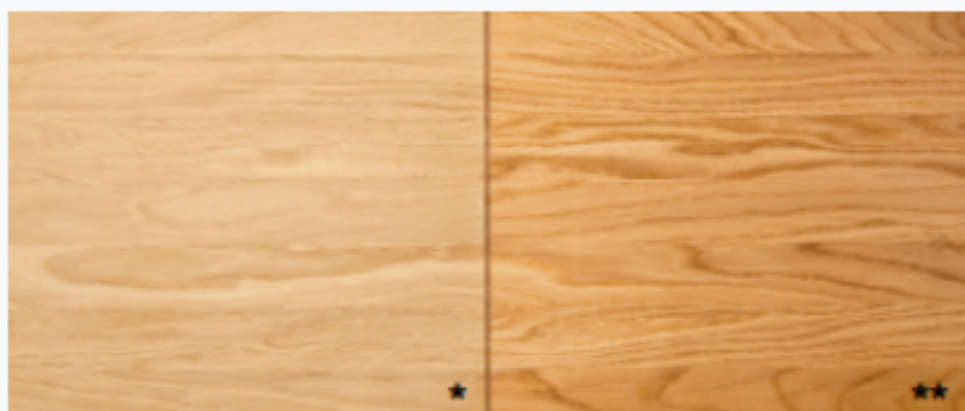


## BEFORE AND AFTER

is the most important European type of wood. The bright knotty wood is used everywhere in interior design and is always on trend.

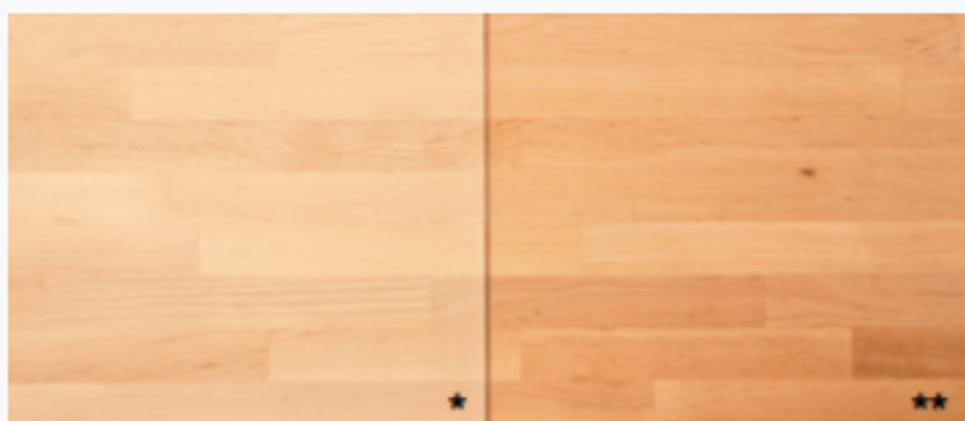
Origin: Scandinavia / Russia

is an unobtrusive predominantly bright wood with a clear and distinctive drawing.

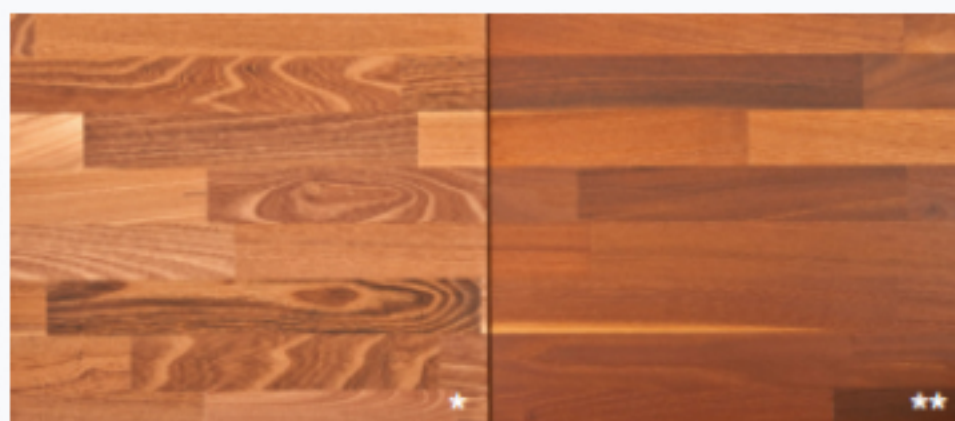
Origin: Europe

shows up as yellow-reddish brown wood with fine pores

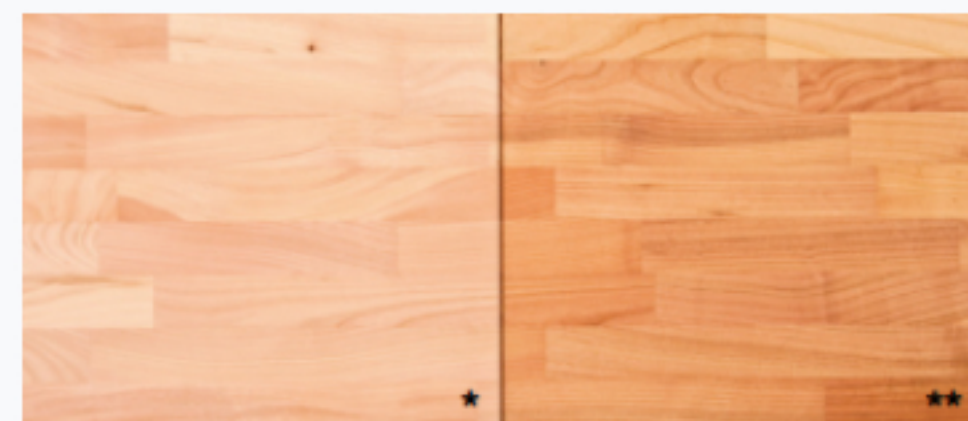

is a rather rare and difficult species to be processed in the most attractive colours.

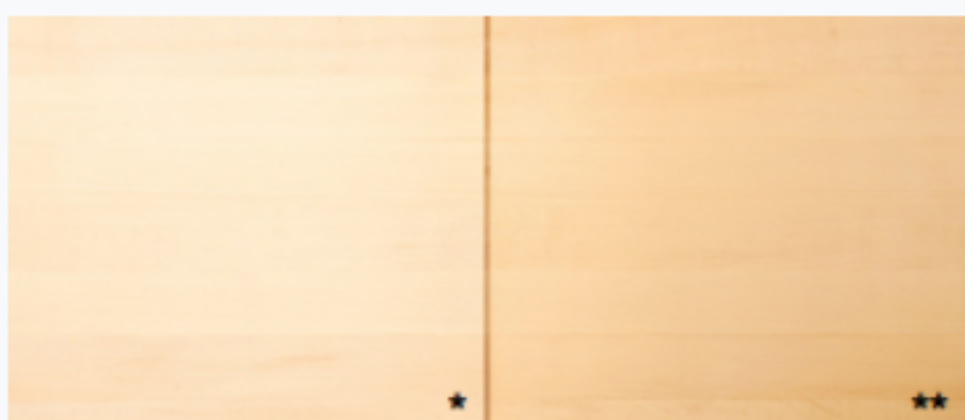
Origin: Europe
